## Amendment to

# 2023-2027 Transportation Improvement Program

The Greater Madison MPO will conduct a public hearing on an amendment to the [2023-2027 Transportation Improvement Program](#). The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), which the Greater Madison MPO updates annually, is a coordinated listing of short-range transportation improvement projects anticipated to be undertaken in the next five-year period. The TIP is the mechanism by which the long-range transportation plan is implemented, and represents the transportation improvement priorities of the region.

The hearing invites comments or concerns regarding the amendment, which would add federal funding to the City of Madison's East-West BRT project as explained in this [memo](#). For more information on the BRT project, see the [project webpage](#). With this amendment, the estimated cost of the East-West BRT project would increase from \$195.88 million to \$211.84 million, with associated increases in federal funding and local funding.
